# A Summary of Q1 2026 Insolvency Filings

Insolvency Insider has provided a detailed overview of the insolvency filings in Canada from the last quarter. We have summarized the most relevant information of the Q1 2026 insolvency filings for those who practice on the Commercial List [here](#).

Insolvency Insider provides the following analysis of the 64 insolvency filings highlighted in Q1 2026.

- Real estate led all industries with 19 filings mentioned, followed by manufacturing with 6 filings, and cannabis, retail and transportation with 4 filings each.
- 26 filings mentioned were in Ontario, followed by 11 in Alberta, 9 in Québec, and 6 each in British Columbia and Newfoundland & Labrador.
- 20 CCAA filings were mentioned. Grant Thornton/Raymond Chabot acted as monitor in 8 of these filings, followed by FTI, EY and A&M with 3 appointments each.
- O'Keefe & Sullivan was engaged on 4 CCAA files as company counsel, followed by Stikeman Elliott with 3 engagements, and Fasken with 2 engagements.
